


In fact, of all our 11 teams competing across the week, no less than seven are second placed on their respective tables. On Saturdays none of our five teams is placed lower than second.

The plan includes proposals to rebuild the Football Clubrooms at an anticipated cost of \$6,588,000; and jointly locate both Tennis Clubs and the Bowls Club into a new Clubroom at an anticipated cost of \$1,813,000. "The master plan is an essential first step in planning the future of the precinct and attracting funding to help deliver the improvements in coming years"



